Could you create a piece of art to share with somebody else? What might it teach them about the character of God?

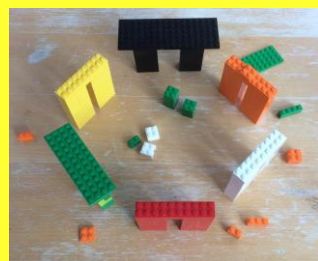
God cares about all the little details of our lives.
